

Garden trip to Sydney 9 October to 11 October 2018

The trip's highlights are a visit to Eryldene and Chanticleer.

Eryldene is regarded as the home of the camellia in Australia. Eryldene is an early twentieth century house and garden in Gordon. It contains many old camellias and is regarded as one of the great camellia gardens.

Chanticleer is a 3 acre English style cottage garden in Arcadia featuring spring and autumn perennials, iris, roses, buxus hedging and deciduous trees. One of the Chanticleer's owners is an artist and her gallery is housed in a French provincial barn.

Lillian Fraser garden is a woodland park.

The Ku-Ring-Gai Horticultural Society have offered to open some of their members' gardens.

There will be a garden visit on the way home (TBC) and wherever possible a plant nursery.

Cost of the 3 day trip is \$440.00 pp twin share and \$110.00 single supplement.

The cost covers the coach, accommodation, 2 dinners, 2 lunches, snacks, tea, coffee and garden entries. Travellers need to bring their lunch on the first day for a picnic at the Lillian Fraser Garden.
